Last year we were pleased to award \$719,370 in grants to 79 nonprofit organizations to support specific projects and programs that are dear to the hearts of our donors, along with \$205,620 in scholarships to 90 area students pursuing their educational dreams.

Thank you to our donors who have partnered with the Foundation to fulfill their philanthropic wishes. Over 50 years the Foundation has grown to over \$27.4 million and administers 340 funds with endowed balances of \$22.2 million. We have truly made a difference in the community by granting over \$12.4 million to the Bryan area in grants and scholarships since 1969.

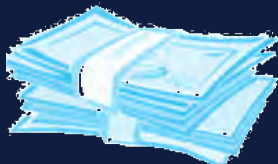
