MEETING GUIDELINES

Choose a Charity

- As a member, you may nominate an eligible nonprofit charity or government entity.
- Three nominations will be drawn at each meeting.
- If your nominee is drawn, you or another member will have five minutes to share about your organization with a Q & A time to follow.
- Members will select the winning organization by secret ballot.



Once an organization has been selected, it will not be eligible for the next four quarterly meetings.

Make Your Donation

- Members write checks made payable to the Bryan Area Foundation for distribution to the selected organization. If you prefer, the annual contribution can be paid in its entirety at the beginning of the year. Automated payment deductions are also an option.
- If you miss a quarterly meeting, your contribution is due within one week of the meeting.

Annual Commitment

- The annual commitment is \$250. Members agree to honor their commitments, even if they are not fond of the charity chosen or if they are unable to attend a meeting.
- The first \$50 each year supports the Power in the Purse Endowment Fund. The endowment fund becomes eligible for distribution after the principal reaches \$25,000.
- At each quarterly meeting, members donate \$50 to the selected charity.

Guests are welcome!

Only members are eligible to nominate, vote or speak on behalf of an organization.
