Criteria

- Open to Williams County high school seniors attending a university, college or technical school
- Minimum GPA 2.5
- Preference given to a student pursuing a degree in or supportive of law enforcement; including probation, corrections, and/or social work/services in a related field of study

STEP 1

Application Process

3. Go to “**Four County Career Center**” for Instructions & Application
4. **Download** and **Save** application prior to completing

Complete Application

Required

- A. Demographic Information
- B. Financial Need Information (Free Application for Federal Student Aid form—<http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>)
- C. Scholarship Questions
- D. Attestation and Grant of Release

STEP 3

Submit Application

DEADLINE: February 18, 2022

1. Print the application
2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section D)
3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
