Criteria

- Open to Williams County high school seniors attending a 2 or 4 year college, university or technical school
- Preference given to a student who intends to study agricultural science, agricultural business, agricultural education, horticulture, animal science, or a related field of study
- Preference given to a student who is employed by, or part of a farming family

Application Process

1. Print the application
2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section E)
3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your high school counselor
4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
