

Richard and James Bard Technical Scholarship Application Process

Criteria

- Open to high school seniors who are residents of Williams County or Fairview High School
- Must pursue a career in HVAC, engineering, or manufacturing
 - o Preference: Field of study in manufacturing skilled trades, CAD/CAM, manufacturing technology or electrical engineering
- Must attend a local community technical or trade school (not a university)
- This is a two-year renewable scholarship, must maintain a C average or better

STEP 1 What you need to know when applying for Foundation Scholarships.

Application Process

- 2. Click on "Scholarships" at the top of the page
- 3. Go to "Bard Technical Scholarship" for Instructions & Application
- 4. **Download** and **Save** application prior to completing

DEADLINE: February 24, 2023

- 1. Print the application
- 2. IMPORTANT Student and Parent signatures required (Section E)
- 3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your high school counselor
- 4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
