Criteria

- Open to Williams County high school seniors attending a 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical school
- Preference given to a student who intends to study agricultural science, agricultural business, agricultural education, horticulture, animal science, or a related field of study
- Preference given to a student who is employed by, or part of a farming family

STEP 1 *What you need to know when applying for Foundation Scholarships.*

Application Process

1. Go to the Bryan Area Foundation website www.bryanareafoundation.org
2. Click on “**Scholarships**” at the top of the page
3. Go to “**Carlin Agricultural Scholarship**” for Instructions & Application
4. **Download** and **Save** application prior to completing

STEP 3

Submit Application

DEADLINE: February 24, 2023

1. Print the application
2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section E)
3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
