



## Bellaire High School - The Robert E. Willis and Elizabeth L. Willis Memorial Scholarship Application Process

*What you need to know when applying for Foundation Scholarships.*

### Criteria

- Open to Bellaire High School seniors planning to attend an accredited university, college, or technical school
- Preference given to a student who intends to major in Business and/or Law
- If no candidates intend to major in Business or Law, preference is given to a graduating senior with a 3.5 GPA or higher. Financial need will also be taken into consideration.

### STEP 1

#### Application Process

1. Go to the Bryan Area Foundation website [www.bryanareafoundation.org](http://www.bryanareafoundation.org)
2. Click on “**Scholarships**” at the top of the page
3. Go to “**High School Scholarships – Bellaire High School**” for Instructions & Application
4. **Download** and **Save** application prior to completing

- B. Financial Need Information (Free Application for Federal Student Aid form—<http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>)
- C. Scholarship Questions
- D. Attestation and Grant of Release

**DEADLINE: February 24, 2023**

1. Print the application
2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section D)
3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
