

Bellaire High School - The Robert E. Willis and Elizabeth L. Willis Memorial Scholarship Application Process

What you need to know when applying for Foundation Scholarships.

Criteria

- Open to Bellaire High School seniors planning to attend an accredited university, college, or technical school
- Preference given to a student who intends to major in Business and/or Law
- If no candidates intend to major in Business or Law, preference is given to a graduating senior with a 3.5 GPA or higher. Financial need will also be taken into consideration.

STEP 1

Application Process

- 1. Go to the Bryan Area Foundation website www.bryanareafoundation.org
- 2. Click on "Scholarships" at the top of the page
- 3. Go to "High School Scholarships Bellaire High School" for Instructions & Application
- 4. Download and Save application prior to completing

STEP 2

Complete Application

- A. Demographic Information
- B. Financial Need Information (Free Application for Federal Student Aid form-http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- C. Scholarship Questions
- D. Attestation and Grant of Release

STEP 3

Important

- Submit Application
- **DEADLINE: February 24, 2023**
- 1. Print the application
- 2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section D)
- 3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
- 4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
