### Criteria

- Open to Williams County high school graduating students planning to attend an accredited university, college, or technical school
- Preference given to a student who attends a technical school and intends to study mechanics and/or mechanical engineering

### STEP 1

#### Application Process

- D. Scholarship Questions
- E. Attestation and Grant of Release

### STEP 3

#### Submit Application

**DEADLINE: February 23, 2024**

1. Print the application
2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section E)
3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
